Criminal Cases in District Court (FY 2009-2014)

Immigration Court (FY 1994 - June 2014)

Asylum denial rates by individual Immigration Judges who have decided at least 100 asylum cases over a six-year coverage period.

Average Closing Time Report for

Judge X
Southern District of New York

For all civil cases disposed of in the Southern District of New York during the 12-month period ending in June 2014 that were credited to Judge X, the average closing time was 341 days. This figure was 14.4% lower than the average closing time for all civil matters disposed of in the Southern District of New York in this period. At the same time, the judge's average closing time was 10.9% higher than typical for the nation as a whole. During the 12-month span covered here, Judge X had disposed of 216 cases. For this group, 64 cases had been pending for one year or more, before being closed.

Focusing only on Judge X's cases that were closed after they had been pending for one year or more, the average closing time was 754 days. This was 8.3% lower than the 821 days typical for this category among the judges in the Southern District of New York and 8.5% higher than the 694 days for the nation.

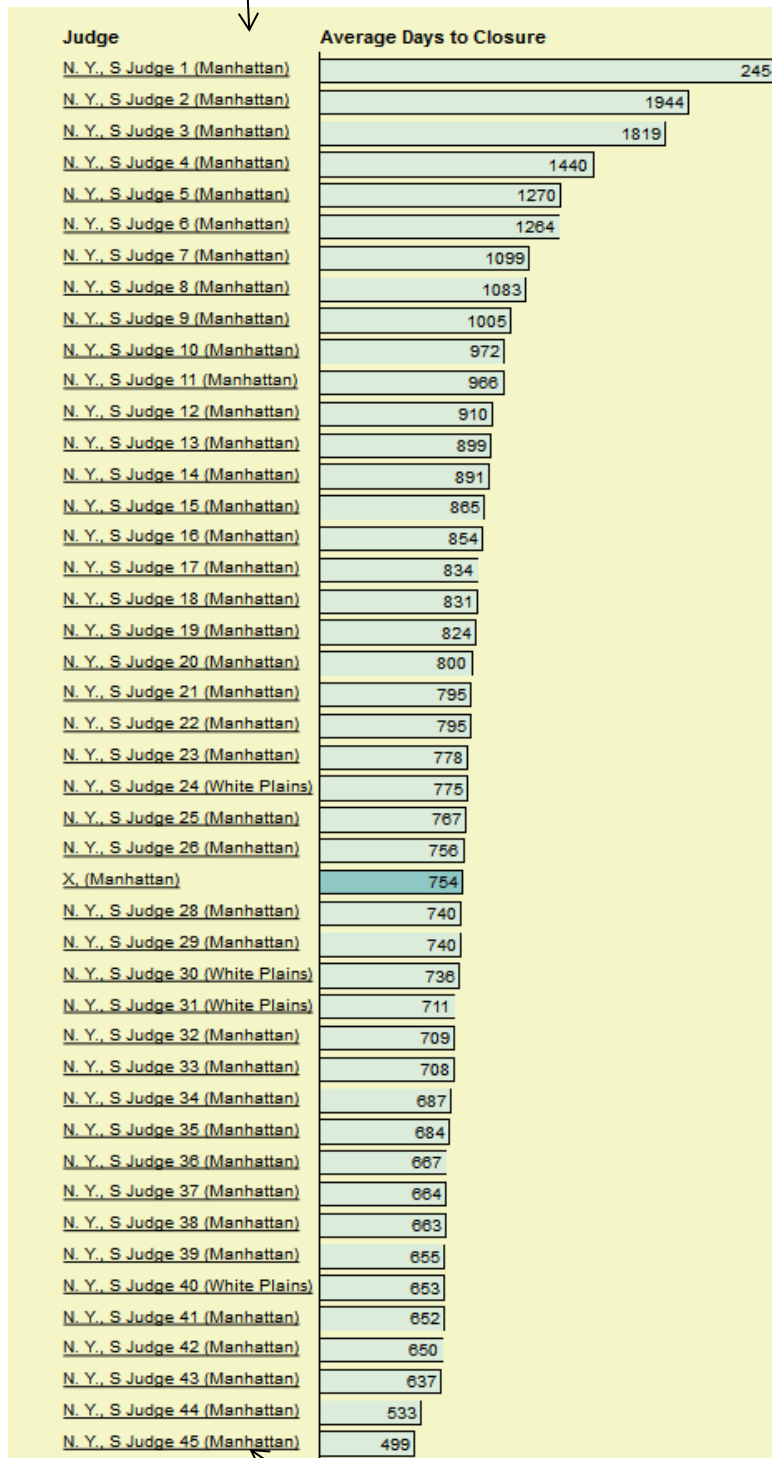


Figure 2: Detailed Comparison among Judges for the Southern District of New York

Nature of Suit in Closed Cases

Cases disposed of by Judge X for the past twelve months fell into a number of broad categories. The most common category for these cases was "Civil Rights" accounting for 25.9% of cases.

Other major categories with cases that were disposed by Judge X over the past twelve months were: Contract (15.7%), Labor (13.4%), Other Statutes (9.3%), Prisoner Petitions (7.9%), Property Rights (7.9%), Torts - Personal Injury - Other (6.9%), Social Security (4.6%), Bankruptcy (2.8%), Torts - Personal Property (1.9%).
